COVID PROTOCOLS FOR HOLY SPIRIT SCHOOL

Health Screening: This screening should be completed at home every morning. The school is not requiring the submission of any health screenings this year, and we are not viewing any submitted screenings, so there is no need to submit a screening to us each morning. Simply answer the questions at home and if all answers are NO your child is able to come to school. These questions are also posted on the main page of our school website.

- Has the student presented with any of the following symptoms: Fever (temperature over 100.0 F) without having taken any fever reducing medication, Loss of Smell or Taste, Muscle Aches, Sore Throat, Cough (without use of cough suppressant medication), Shortness of Breath, Chills, Runny nose/congestion/cold symptoms, Headache/blurred vision/dizziness, Diffuse rash, redness, blemishes or blotches on the skin?
- 2. Has the student experienced any gastrointestinal symptoms such as Nausea/vomiting or diarrhea?
- 3. Has the student, or has any member of the student's household, or anyone the student has been in close contact with, been diagnosed with COVID-19, or been placed on quarantine for possible contact with COVID-19 during the past 14 days?
- 4. Has the student, or any member of the student's household, been asked to self-isolate or quarantine by a medical professional or a local public health official?
- 5. Is your student awaiting the results of a COVID test?

If you answered NO on all questions for your child, he or she is cleared to come to school. If you answered YES to any of the above questions for your child, this means the child has failed the health screening. You must do the following:

- A. Keep your child home from school.
- B. Contact the school office right away so that we can advise you on the best course of action.
- C. If the student is symptomatic, he or she will always need the following to return:
 - a. A negative COVID test result OR a doctor's note attesting to a negative COVID 19 test result
 - b. To be symptom free for 24 hours
- D. If the student is placed in quarantine, we will need:
 - a. A copy of the quarantine order from the local Department of Health
 - b. A copy of the release order confirming the end of the quarantine
