Supplies:

Our 4th grade class will share supplies. The following is a list of supplies our classroom will need for the year. I will pool the supplies for the entire class to share. Thank you in advance!

Communal classroom supplies:

- 2 boxes of tissues and two rolls of paper towels
- 2 boxes of #2 pencils
- 1 pack of pencil top erasers
- 2 large glue sticks and 2 rolls of invisible tape
- 2 packages of loose-leaf notebook paper
- 1 box of sandwich and 1 box of gallon size Ziploc bags
- 1 box of colored pencils (12)
- 1 box crayons (24)
- 1 box of markers (fine-line, 12)
- 1 box of markers (regular, wide tip, 8)
- 2 containers of Clorox cleaning wipes-lemon scent
- 2 12 oz. containers of hand sanitizer

Each student will need: (please label with your student's name)

- backpack big enough to fit a full-size folders, lunch box, water bottle, and snow pants in Winter
- 1 reusable water bottle to bring to and from school every day with clean, fresh, water
- 1 soft pencil case/bag or box with a sturdy clasp
- 2 highlighters (your student's choice of 2 different colors)
- 1 set of dry-erase markers (multiple colors)
